NHEF College Bound: Summer College Admissions Workshops

◆ **Tuesday, June 19 or Tuesday, July 31**

■ **Navigating the College Process: A Road Map** (Parents and Students) (7-8 pm)

Guidance Counselor, Vicki Kellum will provide parents and students with a road map of what you should be doing and when for the college application process.

■ **A Tremendous Tool To Start Your College Search: Naviance Workshop: Demonstration and Hands-on Learning** (Parents) (8-9:30 pm.)

This is a hands-on workshop for parents where Guidance Counselor, Vicki Kellum, will show the college search and career tools in Naviance that are available to you and your student.

◆ **Wednesday, June 20 or Wednesday, August 1**
(3-6 pm.)

■ **College Applications 101: Navigating Both the Common and Coalition Applications** (Students)

Hands-on workshop that will guide you through filling out both the Common Application and Coalition Application. Bring a computer with you and have an account set up in Common and Coalition applications as required.

◆ **Thursday, June 21 or Thursday, Aug 2 (4-6 pm)**

■ **Mock Interviews:** (Students)

Prepare yourself for both a college admissions interview and a job interview. Get feedback and advice from professionals. Individual times will be set up.

College Bound: Essay Writing Workshops (Students)

◆ **June 25-June 29th**
(AM and PM sessions) 9-11:30 am or 1-3:30 pm

North Hunterdon HS English teachers Ms. Cavo and Ms. Fedorko will provide students with the opportunity to start and develop a working draft of their Common Application essay. Students can register for one of two sessions (morning or afternoon) which are 2.5 hours each day for the week. (Cost: \$99.00)

◆ **August 7, 9, 14 and 16**
(Tuesdays and Thursdays 6-8 pm students must attend all 4 sessions)

An Independent College Advisor, Ms. Lori Hofstetter, will guide students to write an effective Common Application essay or personal statement. Students meet Tuesdays / Thursdays for two weeks and will be required to work on their essays between classes. Ms. Hoffstetter will meet individually with each student during the second week and all students will leave the workshop with a working draft of their essays. (Cost: \$450.00)

College Bound: Financial Planning Seminar (Parents and Students)

◆ **Wednesday, July 18th 7:00 pm**

KJM Financial will discuss the FAFSA form and all the other information you need to understand in order to maximize the amount of financial aid you are eligible to receive! Even if your family is not eligible for need-based aid, KJM will cover the best strategies on how to pay for college in the most cost efficient basis — without it putting a strain on the rest of your finances.

College Bound: Individual College Coaching (Students)

◆ **Ongoing throughout July and August**

Sign up for a one hour long individual coaching session with an experienced college coach. A coach will provide personalized counsel, strategies and planning to effectively navigate the college admissions process. The coaching will consist of three components:

1. Introductory emails/calls to identify and align areas of focus.
2. A one hour in-person meeting
3. A written summary at the completion of the engagement
