NHEF College Bound: Essay Writing Workshops

North Hunterdon High School English teachers, Ms. Carr, Ms. Cavo and Ms. Fedorko will provide students with the opportunity to develop a working draft of their college application essay. Students can register for one of six sessions offered. They meet daily for 2.5 hours.

Classes will be 5 days unless a particular class has less than 6 students. For classes with less than 6 students, the same material will be covered but they will finish one day early, on Thursday.
